a. The Climate Social Forum

The Climate Social Forum is a free and inclusive universal assembly. Our goal is to create a virtual "agora" where activists, citizens, and experts can propose actions and stimulate national governments and local administrations to build an ecologically sustainable future. The virtual agora consists of online events (web conferences, virtual meetings, etc...) to encourage the exchange of ideas and proposals. The goal is to create a space for dialogue based on the LISTEN - GENERATIVITY SOLUTION principles and TALANOA dialogue methodology.

b. Government Degree College at Salooni

Government Degree College at Salooni, District Chamba (HP) was established by Government of Himachal Pradesh in September 2006 as co-educational college. Salooni is situated at a distance of about 50 km from the district headquarter Chamba and at an altitude of 1850 meters. The college is surrounded by beautiful cedar trees and apple orchards. Courtyard of the college gives a stupendous view of almost half of the area of Chamba district. At one end of the mid Himalayan range fronting the college stands the snowcapped Sach pass. Other end gradually descends into the Dain kund and Kala Top before eventually making the view of Dalhousie visible. In the darkness of night, the twinkling lamps in Dalhousie town look as if a constellation of young stars had come as pilgrims to earth. The clustered hamlet of houses visible from the college on the front mountain dazzles like a pearl when the sun shines bright during the day. The pleasant weather for the larger part of the year adds yet another feather.

1. Preamble

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into by and between **Climate Social Forum (CSF)** and **Government Degree College Salooni**, hereinafter referred to collectively as “the Parties.”

The Parties mutually recognize the importance of collaboration and cooperation among international and local actors to foster the achievement of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and to effectively combat climate, social, and environmental crises.

The Parties further acknowledge and welcome the key concepts of **Listen, Generativity, Solution**, and the **Talanoa Dialogue**, which constitute the foundational elements and guiding principles of the Climate Social Forum’s “Virtual Agora.”

The Parties mutually recognize the value, mission, and commitment of each institution within their respective contexts and reaffirm their shared dedication to advancing **Peace, Planet, People, and Prosperity** for all.

Recognizing the importance of **Partnerships** in achieving these objectives, the Parties hereby enter into this MoU to foster cooperation in scientific, research, educational, and advocacy activities.

2. Purpose

This MoU establishes a framework for collaboration between the Parties in the fields of:

- Climate action and sustainability
- Social and environmental justice
- Academic research and publications
- Educational initiatives and student engagement
- Public awareness and advocacy activities

All activities undertaken under this MoU shall be conducted on the basis of mutual agreement and availability of the Parties.

3. Areas of Collaboration

3.1 Commitments of Climate Social Forum (CSF)

Climate Social Forum agrees to:

1. **Provide Virtual Agora Facilities**
Make available its digital platforms (including YouTube channel, web portal, mailing lists, Discord channel, and other communication tools) to promote educational and advocacy activities developed within the collaboration.
 2. **Dissemination Support**
Contribute to the dissemination of activities promoted by Government Degree College Salooni and relevant departments within its institutional network.
 3. **Knowledge Bank Access**
Provide access to its knowledge resources (videos, publications, Climate Social Forum outputs, reports, and documentation) for scientific, research, and educational purposes, provided proper reference and citation of sources are maintained.
 4. **Academic Participation**
Participate in scientific, research, and educational activities (including lectures, conferences, workshops, and publications) by providing experts and speakers on relevant topics, subject to availability.
 5. **Internship and Research Opportunities (Remote)**
Offer opportunities for remote internships, research collaborations, and academic exchange to students, researchers, and academic personnel of Government Degree College Salooni.
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3.2 Commitments of Government Degree College Salooni

Government Degree College Salooni agrees to:

1. **Dissemination Support**
Contribute to the dissemination of activities and initiatives of Climate Social Forum within its academic and institutional network.
2. **Academic Collaboration Invitations**
Communicate and invite Climate Social Forum to participate in scientific, research, and educational activities consistent with CSF's mission to address climate, social, and environmental crises.
3. **Academic Participation**
Participate in collaborative activities by providing experts, faculty members, and speakers on relevant topics, subject to availability.

4. Research Contributions

Contribute scientific expertise and academic knowledge to joint research activities, publications, surveys, and studies promoted by the Parties.

5. Visiting and Academic Engagement

Provide opportunities for online or physical visiting sessions for Climate Social Forum representatives to enhance scientific, research, and educational collaboration.

6. Student Engagement

Engage students in Climate Social Forum initiatives, events, and joint scientific publications, promoting experiential learning and active participation.

4. Principles of Cooperation

All activities under this MoU shall:

- Be conducted on the basis of mutual consent and availability;
 - Respect institutional autonomy of both Parties;
 - Maintain academic integrity and transparency;
 - Ensure proper acknowledgment of contributions and sources;
 - Align with shared commitments to sustainability, peace, and inclusive participation.
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5. Duration and Amendment

This MoU shall enter into force on the date of signature by both Parties and shall remain valid for a period of three (3) years, unless terminated earlier by mutual written agreement.

Any further collaboration, expansion of activities, or specific projects may require additional written agreements or amendments to this MoU, to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

6. Non-Binding Nature

This MoU expresses the intentions of the Parties and does not create legally binding obligations. Specific projects may be governed by separate agreements where necessary.




