Flash Mob to Spread HIV/AIDS Awareness on Independence Day Eve:

A flash mob was organized by the Red Ribbon Club (RRC) on 14th August 2024, on the eve of Independence Day, to raise awareness about HIV/AIDS. Students Riya Sharma and Hema from B.A. Third Year, along with Sakshi, Shalu, Riya, and Rita from B.A. Second Year performed energetic dances on patriotic songs to attract public attention. The event successfully engaged around 250 spectators and educated them on HIV/AIDS prevention. This impactful initiative was conducted in collaboration with the NCC and NSS units of the college, combining patriotic spirit with a strong social message to promote health awareness.



RRC Organizes Competitions on HIV/AIDS Prevention Awareness:

The Red Ribbon Club of GDC Salooni, in collaboration with the NSS, RSC and Anti-Drug Awareness Cell, organized a series of awareness competitions on 21st September 2024, focusing on the theme of HIV/AIDS prevention. 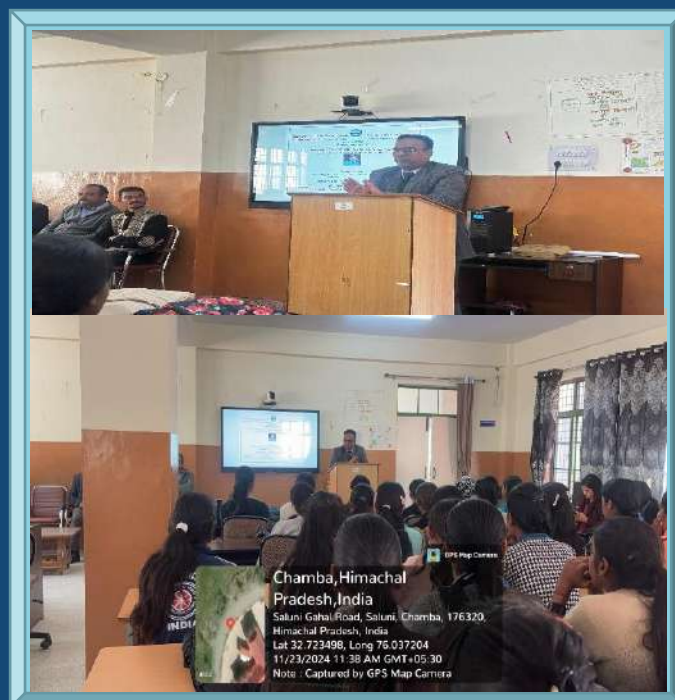

Special Lecture on HIV Awareness Organized by RRC:

On 23rd November 2024, the Red Ribbon Club (RRC) of GDC Salooni organized a special lecture to raise awareness about HIV and related issues. The session was graced by Dr. Sunil Kakkad, Block Medical Officer, Kihar, who contributed as the resource person for the event. Dr. Kakkad delivered an insightful lecture focusing on HIV transmission, prevention, and the importance of timely diagnosis and treatment.

He elaborated on the four primary modes of HIV transmission and addressed various myths and misconceptions surrounding the disease. His talk aimed to educate students and dispel the stigma often associated with HIV. The session was interactive and informative, encouraging students to ask questions and clarify doubts. A total of 82 students actively participated in the event.



Quiz Competition on HIV/AIDS Awareness:

On 27th November 2024, the Red Ribbon Club of GDC Salooni, in collaboration with the Health and Family Welfare Office, Block Kihar, organized a Quiz Competition focused on HIV/AIDS awareness. Dr. Sunil Kakkad, Block Medical Officer, Kihar, was presented on the occasion as a special guest. He appreciated the efforts of the college and participants in promoting HIV awareness through such educational initiatives and encouraged continued involvement.

Skit on HIV Awareness:

The Red Ribbon Club of GDC Salooni celebrated World AIDS Week from 30th November to 5th December 2024 with a series of awareness activities aimed at educating students and the community about HIV/AIDS. 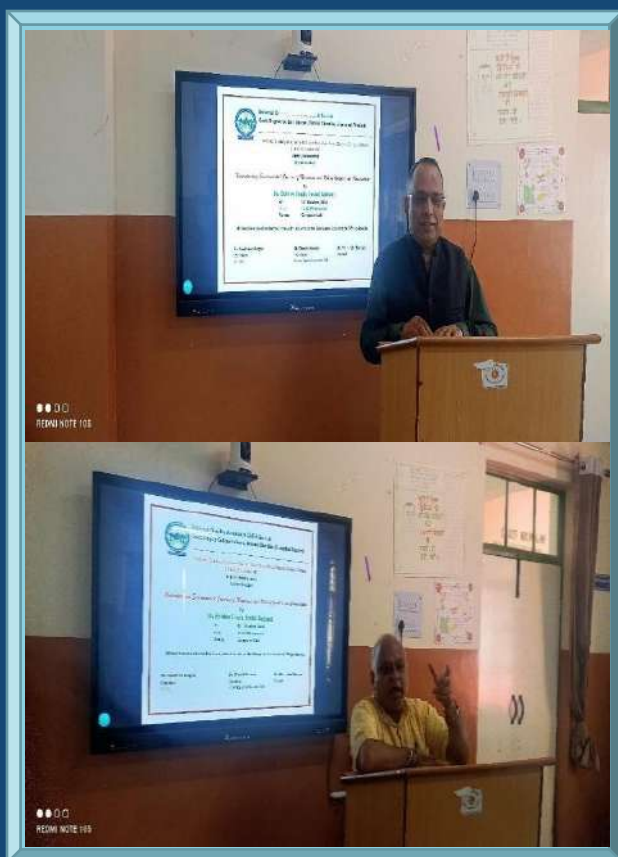

The group first reached the revered Jwalamukhi Shaktipeeth, where Assistant Professor Mr Saurabh Mishra explained the shrine's turbulent past, including medieval invasions and Emperor Akbar's famed gold canopy. On 3 March students explored the Masrur rock-cut temples—often called the "Ajanta of Himachal"—the only Dravidian-style complex in northern India. They then visited the formidable Kangra Fort and its Sansar Chand Museum, studying coins, inscriptions, and paintings, before paying homage at the Brajeshwari Devi Shaktipeeth. Guided by Mr. Mishra and Assistant Professor Mr. Pankaj Kumar, the excursion broadened historical insight and cultural appreciation.

Campus Outreach Programme

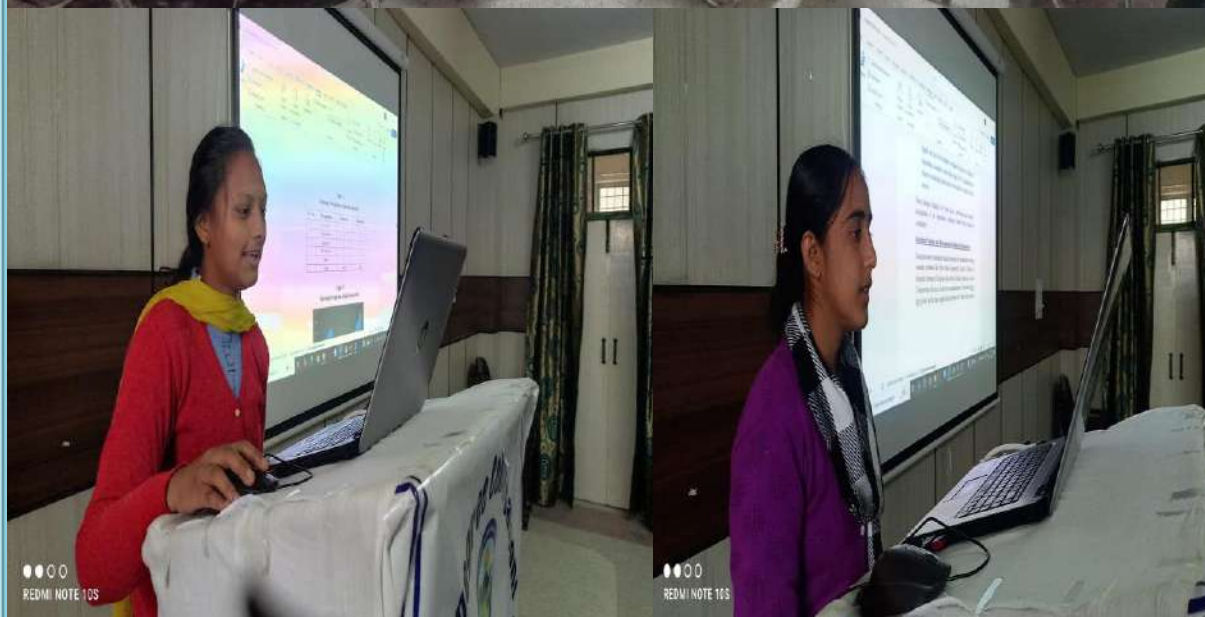
